



## **KETTLE FALLS HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC AGREEMENT**

### ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY

All full-time students who participate in extra-curricular activities shall:

1. Pass six out of six classes the previous semester and six of six they are currently enrolled in order to be eligible for activities during the current semester.
2. Weekly grade checks will be done on Thursday beginning the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of the semester. Students who are failing one or more classes will be ineligible for competition the following Monday through Sunday.
3. Students failing any classes the previous semester are ineligible for 5 weeks.
4. Fall eligibility shall be determined by each student's grades as reported at the end of the previous spring semester (WIAA Standards).
5. Transfer students, for the purpose of eligibility, shall be held to the minimum standards as established by the WIAA. Transfer students will be held to the standards established by Kettle Falls School District each succeeding grade reporting period thereafter. In addition, only credits earned during the previous reporting period maybe applied for the purpose of seeking current eligibility. For Example: a transfer student who earned seven and a half (7.5) credits (the maximum possible at KFHS) at their previous school, could not apply these excess credits beyond their initial activities season at KFHS. Transfer student's grades/transcripts will be evaluated on an individual basis for the purpose of both eligibility and graduation.
6. Successful completion of correspondence courses or other accredited programs may apply to future eligibility requirements only (i.e. the next grade reporting term). No student may apply credits earned beyond one grade reporting period. For example: successful completion of a correspondence course may only be applied to the next grade reporting period for the purposes of attaining athletic eligibility.
7. The Athletic Director's Assistant will create the weekly eligibility list.
8. All students have the right to appeal a determination of ineligibility. This process shall begin by contacting the building principal.
